

# USP Digital Colour Palettes

In order to make it easier for you to work with our colour palettes digitally, we have created a way for all colours to be imported straight into your Adobe Creative Suite. All our digital colours can then be used however you wish, across Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign.

## How to use

The steps below illustrate how to load these USP palettes into your own Adobe Creative Suite files.

### Step 1

Download the relevant .ase file.

### Step 2

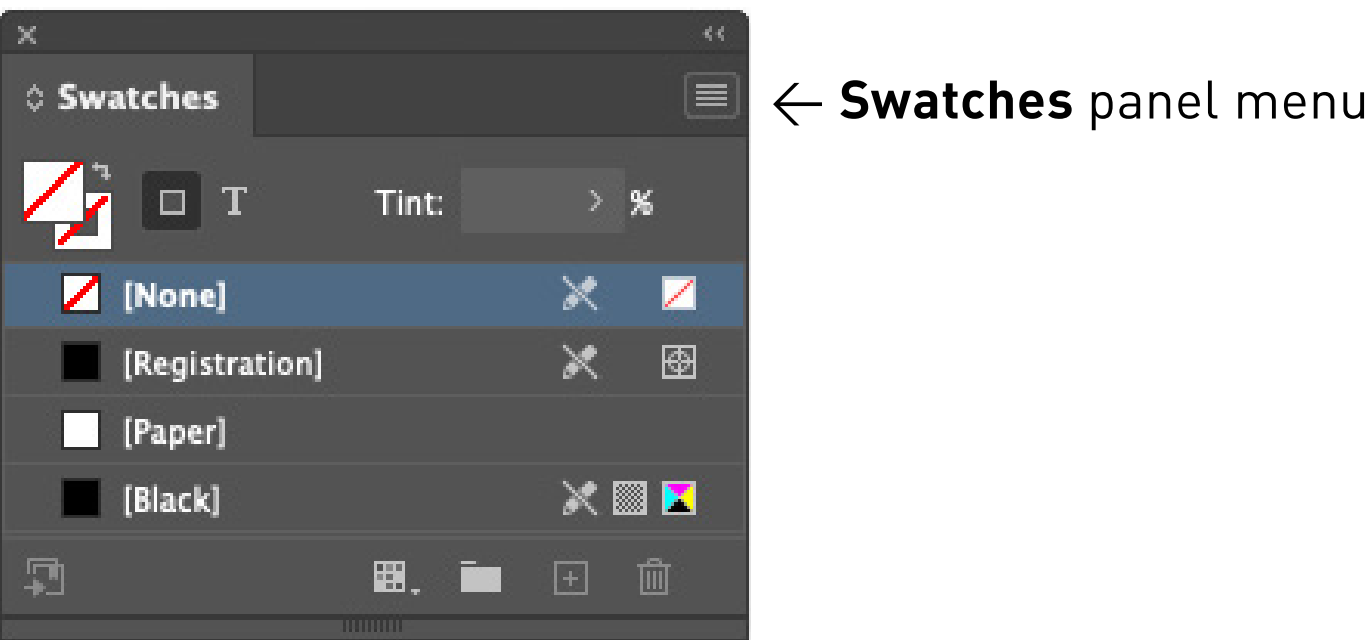
Within your chosen Adobe Creative Suite program open the **Swatches** panel.

Adobe Photoshop / Adobe Illustrator (**Window**→ **Swatches**)  
 Adobe InDesign (**Window** → **Colour** → **Swatches**)

### Step 3

Within the **Swatches** panel open the swatches panel menu. Then, choose the appropriate option below dependant on the Adobe program you are using.

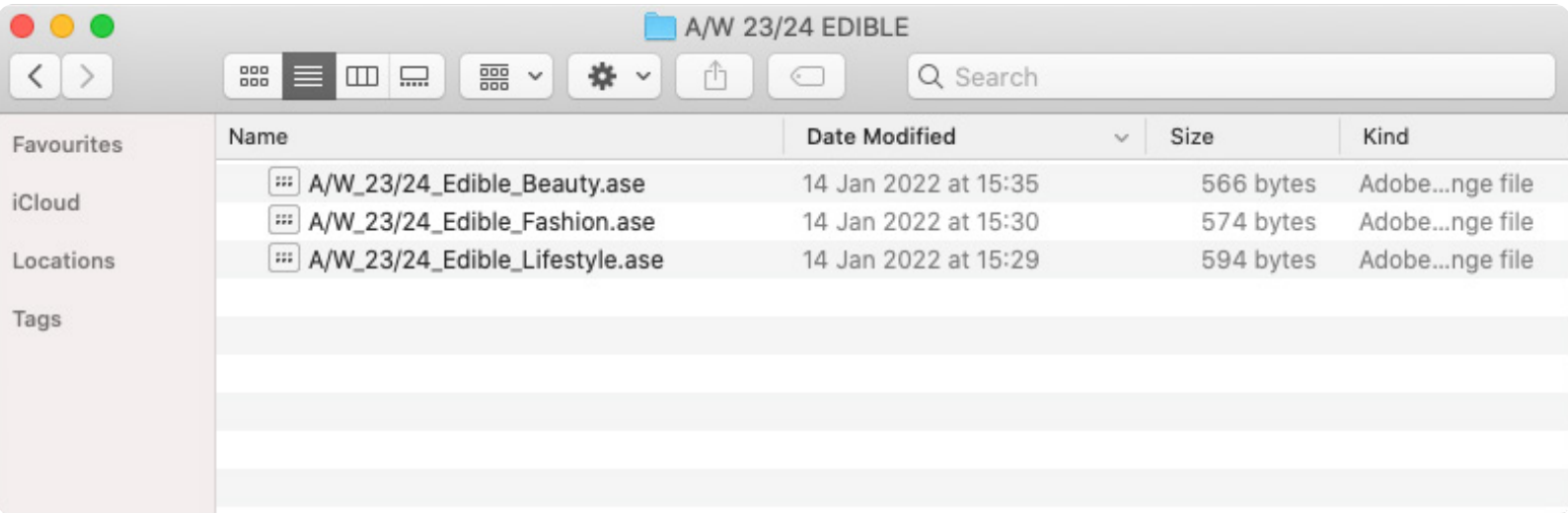
Adobe Photoshop (**Import Swatches**)  
 Adobe InDesign (**Load Swatches**)  
 Adobe Illustrator (**Open Swatch Library** → **Other Library**)



**Note: All colours have been created using the sRGB IEC61966-2.1 colour profile. You can assign this colour profile within any Adobe Creative Suite Program.**

### Step 4

Select the .ase file you would like to include within your file.



### Step 5

The USP palette is now included within the swatches of your file. To view the full colour information and USP numbers select **large list view** within the swatches panel menu.
