Whilst the design show became more of a spectacle this year, there didn't seem to be major standout colour moments. Newness in colour was found through combinations & applications, like the lilac carpet & green upholstery combination seen at the **Miu Miu** literary festival. Glowing finishes that played with glass and lighting lent itself to warm, golden neutrals.

Playful installations & use of materials, like stone supermarket items by **SolidNature** & **OMA/AMO**, made way for unconventional colour combinations. Material drenched spaces were popular - with tactile rooms in varying tones created at **Toogood x Tacchini**.
